- ☐ Decide if you should move out during the remodel, and plan accordingly.

Phase 4: Kick Off Construction

Have a pre-start meeting before construction begins, and answer these questions:

- Will you live in your home during the remodel?
- If you decided to live in your home during the remodel, how will the remodeler protect spaces in your home for you to live in?
- What items in the house are you responsible to remove or relocate?
- What time of the day should the construction workers start work?
- If necessary, where should the port-a-potty be placed?
- Where is the key and alarm code information?
- Where will materials and deliveries be received and staged?
- Where will the workers park?
- How and when will you communicate with the owner, designer, and project manager
- What is an acceptable amount of time to have calls and emails returned?
